Just northeast of THSC is Woodbine Park, which is home to concerts and festivals during the summer, and has a splash pad and playground. All children under 12 must wear lifejackets while on our docks and boardwalk.

VISITOR'S GUIDE

OUR FACILITIES:

• Fully Equipped Kitchen

TH&SC does not have a restaurant. However, we encourage the use of our complete kitchen facilities including cutlery and plates. Since we do not employ staff we ask that when you are finished you clean and return what you have used to their proper storage areas. Nearby restaurant and grocery store locations are detailed further in this guide.

• Barbecues

The club BBQs are located on the south end of the clubhouse in our gazebo and also at the north end of the property by "D" dock.

Showers & Washrooms

These are located on the ground floor at the north end of the clubhouse and are also accessible through the locker room from the parking lot. Additional washrooms are located near the bar, including a family washroom with a baby change station.

• Coin Operated Laundry

A commercial washer and dryer are located in the locker room.



Officer of the Day

A member of our club will be on duty on Friday nights, Saturdays and Sundays, from the long weekend in May to the end of September. An OOD will also be available on statutory holidays.

Reciprocal Privileges

A vessel visiting from a reciprocal club *must fly their burgee*. The first 2 nights are free, thereafter \$20 per night to a combined maximum of 4 nights per visit. TH&SC grants 6 free nights to a reciprocal club per season. A non-reciprocal visitor *(marina)* will be charged \$20 per night to a maximum of 4.

Canada Customs

For our American visitors, remember that when entering Canada from the U.S. you must immediately contact Canada Customs at 1-888-CANPASS. A telephone is located in the clubhouse; local calls only are permitted and are free of charge.

Mooring and Securing

TH&SC has finger docks. Please use two bow lines and one stern and spring line. Remember to tie all halyards and loose lines to minimize noise.

Pump out and Refuelling

Pump out is located at the mast crane and is \$5 for non members. Fuel may be obtained at the Ashbridge's Bay YC fuel dock.

Internet Access

Visitors can access the club wifi. The code is 1234567890.

Shopping and Restaurants (North & East):

There are stores along Queen St. east and west of Coxwell about a 15 minute walk from TH&SC. On the west, you will find a McDonald's, and the Tulip (*known for their breakfasts*), next door there is a small hardware store. East of Coxwell there is Harvey's, KFC, The Burger's Priest and Casa di Giorgio. Beer and liquor can be purchased at the LCBO in this strip.

West on Lakeshore Blvd:

Loblaws (beer now available) and FRESH Co. along with a Wendy's - Tim Hortons and a Starbucks are at Lakeshore E. and Leslie St.; approximately 2 km west of the club (*approx. a 20 minute walk*). Canadian Tire (Service Ontario), Marks, Shoppers Drug Mart, and TD Bank are to the south.

The Beaches

If you are in the mood for a great walk with a variety of cuisine and shops, then the Beaches area is for you. You can also get there and back by walking up to Queen St. and catching the streetcar.

Public Transportation
