As part of Parks, Forestry and Recreation's commitment to keep leaseholders and partners informed, we would like to provide you with an important update.

Following the advice from Ontario's Chief Medical Officer of Health, on April 3, the Province of Ontario updated the list of essential businesses that can remain open. The restrictions are aimed at further reducing contact between people and stopping the spread of COVID-19. The Transportation Services section of the list has been updated to allow the continued operation only of businesses that provide transportation services and support services for transportation services, as well as marinas, but only to the extent that the marina is necessary to enable individuals to access their primary place of residence.
