

PRIVACY POLICY

The Toronto Hydroplane and Sailing Club (Club) respects your privacy and is committed to protecting it.

This Privacy Policy explains how we collect, use, maintain, and disclose personal information collected and how we protect your privacy when you visit the THSC website [Toronto Hydroplane and Sailing Club](#) , contact us by email or telephone, or visit our premises.

THE TYPES OF INFORMATION WE COLLECT

Personal identification information

By “personal information”, we mean information that directly identifies you or by which we can identify you. The personal information that we typically collect from our members includes contact information (name, home address, home phone number, business address, business phone number, cellular number and e-mail addresses) as well as birthdate and the name of a member’s spouse and children. We may collect personal identification information from you in a variety of ways, including, but not limited to, when you visit our website, subscribe to newsletters, respond to a survey, fill out a form, and in connection with other activities, services, features or resources we make available. You may be asked for, as appropriate, name, email address, mailing address, phone number. You may, however, visit our website anonymously. We will collect personal identification information from you only if you voluntarily submit such information to us. You can always refuse to supply personal identification information, but it may prevent you from engaging in certain website related activities.

Non-personal identification information

We may collect non-personal identification information about you whenever you interact with our website. Non-personal identification information may include your device and browsing information, including information about your phone, tablet, computer, or device, and online browsing activity (collectively, “automatically collected information”).

Automatically collected information may include IP addresses, unique device identifiers, cookie identifiers, device and browser settings and information, and internet service provider information. Automatically collected information also may include information about when and how you access and use our website, such as the date and time of your visit or use, the websites you visit before coming and after leaving our website, how you navigate our website and the website pages and items you view.

HOW AND WHY WE USE YOUR INFORMATION

In general, we collect personal information required for the Club's operational use, including contact information, demographic information and information about individual preferences. We collect information on our website, during calls with you, and while you are on Club premises.

The Toronto Hydroplane and Sailing Club may collect and use your personal information for the following purposes:

To process membership applications and administer memberships – this includes the Club maintaining a roster of Members (consisting of Members' names and contact information) and making the roster available online to other Members to foster engagement and connection. The personal information in the Club's roster may only be used for purposes related to the Club such as facilitating sailing and sports activities between Members. The Club will not make a member's personal information available to other Members in the roster online if a member contacts the Club by sending an email to vice-commodore@thsc.ca and requests that their personal information not be available in the roster online.

- To provide secure access to facilities, products and services
- To improve customer service – the information you provide us helps us respond to your customer service request and support your needs more efficiently.
- To tailor services to meet individual preferences – We may use information in the aggregate to understand how our users as a group use the services and resources provided on our website.
- To improve our website – We may use feedback you provide to improve our products and services.
- To process payments – We may use the information you provide about yourself when placing an order only to provide service to that order. We do not share this information with outside parties except to the extent necessary to provide the service.
- To administer surveys, contests, promotions or other features – To send information you agreed to receive about topics we think will be of interest to you.
- To communicate information about our facilities, products, and services – We may use the email address to send information and updates pertaining to our facilities, products and services. It may also be used to respond to enquiries, questions, and/or other requests. If at any time you would like to unsubscribe from receiving future emails, we include detailed unsubscribe instructions at the bottom of each email.

CHANGING INFORMATION

You can review and change your personal information through the edit my profile option on the Club website or by contacting us by sending an email at vice-commodore@thsc.ca or writing to us at the address specified in the “Contact Us” section. We rely on you to inform us of changes to your contact or other relevant information (e.g., name, address, telephone number, change of status etc.). We may not accommodate a request to change information if we believe the change would violate any law or legal requirement or cause the information to be incorrect.

HOW WE PROTECT YOUR INFORMATION

We adopt appropriate data collection, storage and processing practices and security arrangements to protect your personal information against such risks as unauthorized access, collection, use, disclosure, copying, modification disposal or destruction. This involves ensuring that the individuals who view your personal information are those who have the need to do so, and that where necessary and appropriate, sensitive Personal Information may be locked in secure filing cabinets. All our staff are trained to collect, use and disclose Personal Information only as necessary to serve our members or guests needs and in accordance with this Privacy Policy. Electronically, all computers and computer network may only be accessed with passwords which are updated regularly. Due to the nature of the internet, however, no data transmission over the internet is fully secure. Please be aware of this before you send us any personal information through the website as the TH&SC cannot guarantee that any information that you transmit to us will not be intercepted and/or misused by third parties.

SHARING YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION

We do not sell, trade, or rent your personal identification information to others. We may share generic aggregated demographic information not linked to any personal identification information regarding visitors and users with our business partners, trusted affiliates, and advertisers for purposes outlined above. However, in general, we do not share personal information about you with third parties for third-party marketing or advertising purposes. We may use third-party service providers to help us operate our business and the website or administer activities on our behalf, such as sending out newsletters or surveys. We may share your information with these third parties for those limited purposes provided that, you have given us your permission.

COOKIES

Our website may use “cookies” to enhance user experience. A cookie is a small computer

file or piece of information that may be stored in your computer's hard drive when you visit our website. Cookies are widely used, and most web browsers are configured initially to accept cookies automatically. You may choose to set your web browser to refuse cookies, or to alert you when cookies are being sent. Please note, however, if you disable cookies, you may not experience optimal performance of our website.

THIRD-PARTY WEBSITES

Our website may contain links to other third-party websites that are not governed by this Privacy Policy. Although we endeavor to only link to websites with high privacy standards, our Privacy Policy will no longer apply once you leave our website.

Additionally, we are not responsible for the privacy practices employed by third-party websites and cannot be held liable for the actions of those third parties. Therefore, if you navigate to other websites, please review the privacy statements of those websites to learn how your information may be collected, used, shared and disclosed.

YOUR ACCEPTANCE OF THESE TERMS

In accordance with the Club's By-Laws and Rules and Regulations, all Members must comply with this policy. If you are not a member, by using the Club's website or providing any personal information to the Club, you signify your acceptance of this policy. If you do not agree to this policy, please do not use our website. Your continued use of the website following the posting of changes to this policy will be deemed your acceptance of those changes.
